Students will demonstrate an understanding of some of the great movements and individuals in the arts.	<p>Students will examine different forms of art and its creation, presentation, and impact in an historical context.</p> <p>Students will examine the role of the individual in the creation and presentation of an artwork.</p> <p>Students will compare and contrast various movements in the arts. Such analysis might be done within a specific branch of the arts or across disciplines.</p>	<p>Research papers</p> <p>Examinations</p> <p>Projects</p> <p>Presentations</p> <p>Written critiques of concert performances, films, visual art presentations, etc...</p>
